

WAYS TO PRAY WITH KIDS

NIGHT & MORNING PRAYERS

Build in prayer times in kids' routines. Ask them what they'd like to pray about and listen.



PRAYER ROCKS

Go on a walk and find rocks of all different shapes and sizes. Then take chalk pens and google eyes and decorate the rocks. Then go on a prayer mission and leave these rocks in public places and pray together for whoever might see this rock. Or even give these prayer rocks to people who need a blessing.



PRAYERBALL

Get a beach ball and with your child draw pictures of things to pray for, such as pets, friends, etc. Have a fun time tossing the beach ball to each other and when someone catches the beach ball they can pray for the picture or word touched by a thumb.



PRAYER BEADS

Have fun letting them choose wooden beads and string and even decorate the beads with paint pens or sharpies with things they'd like to pray for. Then let them place them using a key ring on their backpack or make a bracelet or necklace.



AMBULANCE PRAYER

Stop to pray every time you hear an ambulance, police car, or fire truck.
